

PAFA "Player Drop" Refund Policy

Due to the extensive growth of the PAFA program and the number of volunteers necessary to operate the multiple aspects of the program, PAFA will need to make adjustments to prior policies. These are not meant to cause undue difficulties for those that choose to drop from the program, however with the difficulty in arranging a travel program, the investment in equipment required to support those players that choose to drop after those investments are made, and the efforts to provide for fair and balanced teams the following drop process will be applied for 2010 season.

From the start of registration in February up to June 12th, all monies will be refunded less a \$50 administration fee. This is completed in person by the parent at the Palatine Park District offices on Wood Street, Palatine.

From June 12 up until the last Thursday before the first day of practice, 50% of all monies paid are refunded less a \$50 administration fee. This refund is a two-part process. The first step to complete a refundable drop is in person by the parent; visit the Palatine Park District offices on Wood Street, Palatine. The second is to notify the PAFA organization through our website. The registration refund will be supplied to the parent (less fee) the fees paid to PAFA to that point will be returned at the rate defined on the last official drop date. This date is Thursday, July 29th before the first week of practice, which this year is Mon. Aug. 2nd. On that date the PAFA treasurer will be available to issue you're a check for the appropriate refund.

From the day after the final drop day, throughout the season there is no refund available except the security deposit upon the return of the equipment. To receive your equipment deposit refund, the equipment must be returned to PAFA. If the drop occurs during the season, special arrangements must be made for the return of the equipment. The appointment for return can be arranged through the web site e-mail.
